During the first years of their marriage, Walter and Amanda Kuse lived on a small twenty-acre farm. The eastern edge extended to a line approximately even with Woodland Road. In 1937, Grandpa Gustav Janke gave his daughter, Amanda Janke Kuse, money so the family could buy more much needed pasture land. Fifteen adjacent acres were purchased from Augusta Billings, a daughter of the John and Johanna Billings family. The new portion was covered with MANY ROCKS but the cows could graze among them.
