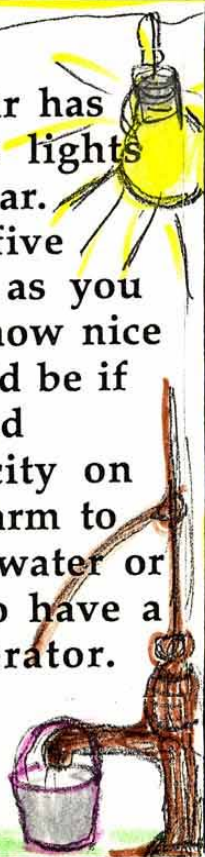
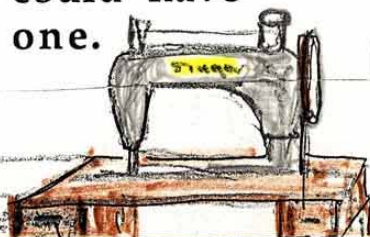


The fair has electric lights this year. Move five spaces as you think how nice it would be if you had electricity on your farm to pump water or even to have a refrigerator.



1908

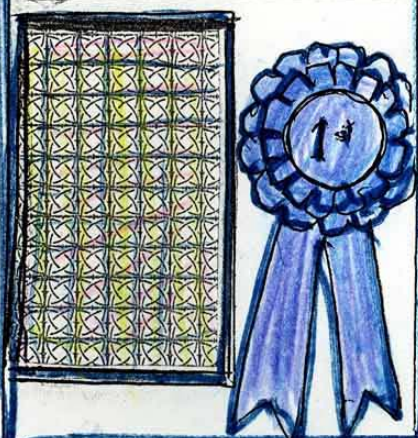
You see a treadle sewing machine in the merchant's building. Move 5 spaces as you think how nice it would be if your mother could have one.
